








### Noteworthy Eagle Members



As we get into late summer, some of us maybe already have or are going to attend a baseball game. Did you know one of the most famous baseball players, Joseph "Joe" DiMaggio aka the Yankee Clipper was an Eagle.

Joe DiMaggio played 13 years for the New York Yankees. Joe is known for holding the longest hitting streak in American Baseball. He was a three-time American League MVP and an Allstar in all his 13 seasons.

At the end of his career, he ranked 5th in home runs with a total of 361 home runs. In the 1950's, Joe was a celebrity, and everyone knew his name. DiMaggio was also married to the famous actress Marilyn Monroe. Joe passed away on March 8<sup>th</sup>, 1999.
