Last Chance to Pay 2023-2024 Dues

All Aerie & Auxiliary members who have not paid their dues for this fraternal year (2023-2024) will be dropped on July 11th. Anyone who is dropped from the membership system will no longer be a member in good standing and will be required to re-enroll by filling out an application, paying the re-enrollment fee and the membership dues. Anyone who has been dropped is not allowed to come into the Social Room, even as a guest.

Three dues reminders were mailed and one reminder phone call went out. If you have not received any dues reminders, your address may have changed and has not been updated with the Aerie or Auxiliary Secretaries or you may have an expiration date of 2024 or later. The way to be sure is to look at your yellow (Aerie) or white (Auxiliary) membership receipt where your name and expiration date is printed in red. If your door card is not working, check your membership card to see if it has expired.

Pay your dues directly to the Aerie or Auxiliary Secretary to ensure the payment is credited on time. **Do not wait until the last day!** Dues will not be taken at the bar.

We have several photos of long since passed members on our floats. One of the more notable floats was modeled after the steam ships that graced the waters of Lake Coeur d'Alene. The money that is generated by your generous donations through raffles, ticket sales, collections, bar sales, and direct donations get turned around back into our local community. Benefits that include education grants, medical, dental, and more for your kids. Medical benefits are until your kids are 18 and educational benefits are until they are 25. If you are unsure if you were initiated in the full ceremon,. I would encourage you to go through initiation again and renew your pledge to the Eagles. Any member can renew their obligation to the Eagles at any time. If you are a member that has kids over 18 and 25, I encourage you to think about giving the gift of membership to your kids, so your grandkids are covered. Several older Eagles members pay for their kid's dues and have them get initiated, even though they may not be involved in the Eagles, so their grandkids are covered.
