Dear Members,

We would like to clarify some confusion regarding the March 2025 drink pricing changes.

Some members have understood the recent adjustment to mean that sales tax was built into the new drink prices. This is not correct. At the time those adjustments were made, the increase reflected rising costs of goods over several years that had not previously been incorporated into our pricing.

During a recent update to better integrate Idaho based on gross sales. This has resulted in the Aerie absorbing approximately \$5,000 per month – or nearly \$60,000 per year – in sales tax expenses. This oversight has created a significant and unintended financial burden on our membership.

Effective March 1, a 6% sales tax will now be applied to all purchases for both members and non-members. Although costs everywhere continue to rise, this should not be confused with a drink price increase. Our drink prices remain unchanged; the difference you will see reflects the proper addition of state sales tax.

This correction is essential to protect the financial stability of Aerie 486, maintain our 15th Street Pavilion and our historic building on Sherman Avenue, and, most importantly, strengthen our ability to give back to local charities and our community.

We understand that change can be challenging and sincerely apologize for any inconvenience. These adjustments will ensure that Aerie 486 remains fiscally responsible and strong for years to come.






