I will do my best to continue the tradition of the Eagles in helping our Aerie better serve the community through charitable donations and volunteerism.

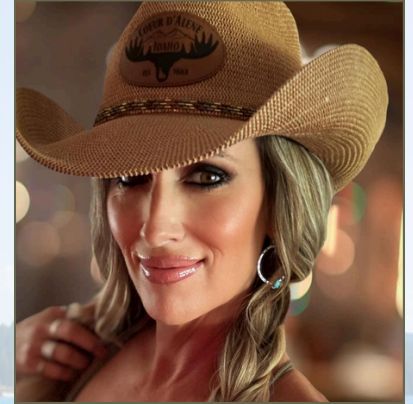

Greetings from your Board of Trustees,

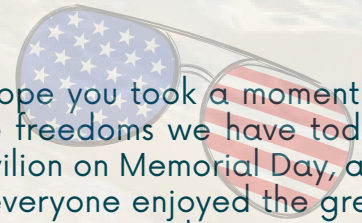
