## Important Membership Card Information

Beginning in July 2026, the Grand Aerie will begin issuing hard plastic membership cards to all members in good standing.

Following the annual delinquent member drop on July 11, the Grand Aerie will send the list of members in good standing to the company that will print and mail the new cards. Cards will be printed and mailed throughout the month of July. (Please remember to renew your membership prior to July 11, to avoid being dropped. Dropped members must re-enroll, which requires a re-enrollment application and an additional \$20.00 fee.)

After the initial mailing, newly initiated and re-enrolled members will automatically have their information sent to the printer through weekly updates, and their membership cards will be mailed directly to them.

What you need to know:

- Your new membership card will be mailed directly to the address we have on file.
- If your mailing address has changed, please notify the Secretary as soon as possible to ensure you receive your card.
- If a card is returned as undeliverable, it will be sent back to the Aerie, and you will be contacted to pick it up and update your address.
- For the 2026–2027 membership year, both the yellow dues receipt and the new hard membership card will be accepted as proof of membership.
- Beginning with the 2027–2028 membership year, only the hard membership card will be recognized as your official proof of membership.

The Grand Aerie is also developing a new door entry system that will work with the QR code on the new membership cards. Additional information will be shared once that program is finalized.
